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Wyandotte Municipal Services Trade Ally Policy

Energy Smart is a portfolio of programs promoting energy efficiency and conservation, including rebates and education. The Energy Smart program offers financial incentives to participating building owners and contractors.

Contractors who meet certain training and program participation standards are given Trade Ally status.

The Energy Smart Trade Ally Policy and Application define the terms under which the contractor agrees to participate in the Trade Ally program.

Trade Ally participation standards include:

- Maintaining good customer service performance and representing the Energy Smart Trade Ally program appropriately.
- Attending an annual training session and submitting a signed Trade Ally participation agreement.
- Submitting at least one application per program year.
- Submitting final application paperwork within 90 days of the funds reservation letter.

Benefits of participation include:

- Access to free exclusive program training.
- Access to the Trade Ally Portal on the Energy Smart website.
- Your company listed as a registered program Trade Ally on the Energy Smart website.
- Supplies of printed marketing materials.
- An assigned Energy Advisor to assist with the program.
- Eligibility to receive third party checks.

The Energy Smart program team will review all applications, verify the information and contact the references listed. If any information is missing or inadequate, we will contact you to request an update. You will be notified via email when your application is approved.

Restrictions:

- Applicant must be either an installer, a general contractor, an architecture and engineering firm, or a supplier of qualifying equipment to be eligible.
- Use of the Energy Smart logo in any format is strictly prohibited without the express written approval of the Energy Smart program.
- Co-branding is not allowed and will result in removal as a Trade Ally.
- Trade Allies may provide a link to the list of approved Trade Allies on the Energy Smart website.

- Contractors' Trade Ally program status and participation are at the sole discretion of the Energy Smart program. Participation standards are subject to change.
- Trade Ally status does not imply a utility endorsement of the contractor in any way; rather it simply provides a way to identify those contractors who have completed the required training.
